



Make your own wine card

Ingredients:

Special Christmassy paper - Size A4, 150gsm or more
(careful not to go too thick - your printer might not cope).

Nice envelopes - 5.5 inch squared

Your choice of festive wine - deep reds work well, but more importantly, select one you enjoy drinking!

A wine glass and a plate

Several corks

A sharp craft knife, ruler & pencil

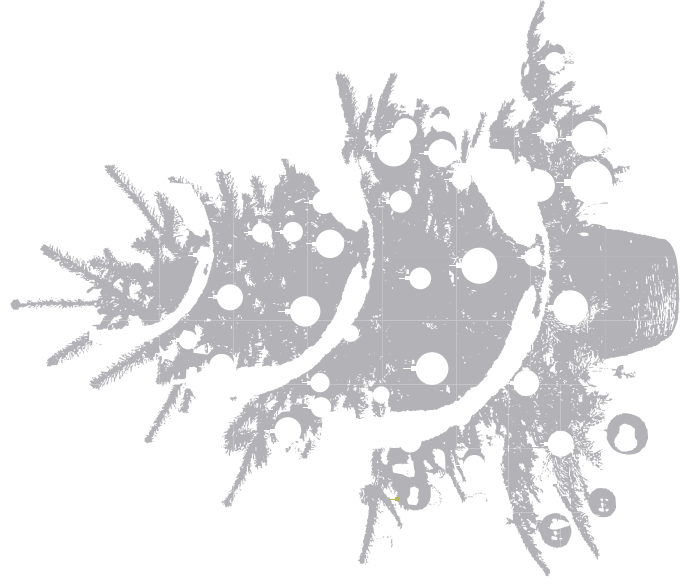


Instructions (it's worth testing with normal paper first):

- Print** - Put your posh paper in and print page 2 of this PDF on one side of each piece, and on the other side print page 3. (Definitely do this before opening the wine.)
- Trim** - Using your knife and ruler and the handy crop marks, carefully cut out your cards.
- Carve** - Draw a star shape on one end of a cork and using the knife, carve it out. (This bit can be fiddly, hence the need for several corks. Also, be careful of your fingers so take your time!)
- Stain** - Pour some wine onto the plate, and use the base of a glass as a rudimentary stamp to fill in the tinsel. Then use the cork to add a jaunty star on the top.
- Score and fold** - Locate the centre of your card, and using the back of your craft knife (that's right, the blunt side) lightly and slowly score what will be the spine of the card. Then fold it closed.
